Caribbean countries offer to collaborate with Nigeria to achieve food security

Caribbean countries are expressing their readiness to share their expertise and skills in agriculture with Nigeria to support its food production, in addition to the oil and gas sector, as food security has become a global concern. Caribbean representatives urged the Nigerian government to revive subsistence farming and encourage citizens to grow their own food, citing backyard gardens as an example.
